

4th Strategic Forum “Transport Infrastructure of Russia”

On **September 19–20, 2018**, Moscow will host **the 4th Strategic Forum “Transport Infrastructure of Russia”**. Held with the support of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation, the Forum is a part of the ROSINFRA Infrastructure Congress’ event series organized by the National Center for PPP and the Roscongress Foundation.

This year, transport infrastructure development issues received an unprecedented attention from the nation’s leadership. According to the Presidential Decree issued in May, which determines national development goals for the next six years, the Government must develop and approve a comprehensive plan for highway infrastructure modernization and expansion based on the spatial development strategy by October 1, 2018. The objective is to enhance the economic cohesion of Russia’s territory through developing transportation lines between regional administrative centers, which should be achieved by modernizing airports, building high-speed railroads, increasing the throughput capacity of domestic waterways, building road infrastructure and introducing intelligent transportation systems.

Considering that significant funding is required to lift infrastructure limitations in the transport system — road construction alone needs a twofold increase in the current government spending up to 11 trillion rubles) — the key goal of the Strategic Forum “Transport Infrastructure of Russia” is to develop suggestions on new transportation network development mechanisms.

Every year, the Forum features representatives of relevant federal and regional government authorities, banks, infrastructure and construction companies, and major legal and consulting firms.
